What personal data do we collect and why?

In order to comply with the Market Abuse Regulation (MAR (EU) 596/2014), the data we collect on Atria Plc's management and their related parties includes the following: name and previous names of senior manager or related party, personal identity number or date of birth, address, telephone number, email address, employer's name and address, position of senior manager and related party, basis for being a related party, date of commencement and termination of senior manager / related party, business notifications received from data subjects and published. In addition, we may collect other data required by the authorities or the Market Abuse Regulation or related statutes.

The personal data is generally collected from the individuals themselves, the book-entry system or public information sources.

The personal data will not be used in direct marketing, automated decision-making or profiling.

How do we process, store and protect personal data?

Access to personal data is limited to those who need the data to manage their duties. For the purposes in accordance with the Market Abuse Regulation, the data may be disclosed to entities referred to in the Regulation, such as the Financial Supervisory Authority and the police.

In processing personal data and planning processing, we comply with the EU General Data Protection Regulation, in force as of 25 May 2018. Data processed by an IT system is stored in a system maintained by Euroclear Finland Oy, the data connection to which is SSL encrypted. Access to the register data is restricted to persons within Atria's insider administration and their substitutes. In the system, the data is technically and organisationally protected. Data in the systems is backed up regularly. To maintain its systems, Euroclear Finland may use third-party service providers whose partners may work outside the EU/EEA. These agreements take into account the standard clauses of the European Commission or other appropriate safeguards.

How long do we store personal data?

We store personal data for the time required by the Market Abuse Regulation.

Rights of the data subject

You have the right to:

- Gain access to your personal data and obtain a copy of your personal data
- Request rectification of your personal data and, under certain conditions, erasure
- Under certain conditions, request restriction of processing or object to processing of personal data
- In certain cases, request transfer of your personal data to another system
